This campaign of arrests launched by the troops of the Office of Nuri al-Maliki; is a primitive policy to preclude the expansion of the current mass protests across the country after the deadline set by Al-Maliki in which he promised the implementation of economic and social reforms.

While Iraq Freedom Congress condemns such acts that reveal the hypocrisy of al-Maliki and his sectarian government about democracy, it announce that these arrests will not stop our movement from continuing our demonstrations until our demands are met..
